

Cousineau Auto Parts Inc. - 90 day Limited Part Warranty

Subject to the limitations below Cousineau Auto Parts Inc. expressly warrants to the *original purchaser* for 90 days from the date of purchase against the failure of the part as specifically described on the packing slip accompanying such part due to defects in Cousineau Auto Parts Inc.'s materials or workmanship (a defective part). **Any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness of a particular purpose are limited to the extent allowed by law and to the time period covered by this written warranty.** If the purchaser complies with the terms of this warranty, Cousineau Auto Parts Inc. will repair or replace a defective part once without additional shipping costs to you. Cousineau Auto Parts Inc. may, at its discretion, provide a refund equal to the price paid for the part in lieu of repair or replacement of the part. The foregoing is the only, sole, and exclusive remedy under the terms of this warranty. **In the event of a part failure, please contact Cousineau Auto Parts Inc. to start the warranty process.**

Cousineau Auto Parts Inc. - Limited Labor Warranty

If a labor warranty is purchased, the warranted part is installed by an ASE-certified mechanic, and the recommended maintenance work as stated on the installation checklist tag attached to the part is performed at the time of installation, Cousineau Auto Parts Inc. will provide a limited labor warranty equal to the length of the parts warranty from the date of original purchase, subject to the terms, exclusions, general and specific limitations of our part warranty. Labor reimbursement will be in accordance with the Mitchell, AllData or other published labor guide labor guide installation hourly rate, shall not exceed the rate of \$50.00 per hour, and shall not exceed the labor rate or charged hours of the original installation or \$500 whichever is less. Normal maintenance according to the manufacturer's specifications must be performed and documented.

Exclusions

1. Incidental or consequential damages including, but not limited to, damage to or the cost of related parts, loss of income, travel expenses, loss of transportation, towing fees, rental vehicles, or diagnostics are not covered by this warranty
2. Parts installed in a vehicle that is used in a fleet or for commercial purposes are not covered by this warranty.
3. Parts installed in a vehicle used for competition, raced (whether on road or off road, sanctioned or not), or used for off road purposes are not covered by this warranty.
4. Parts installed in a vehicle that has been modified from its original factory configuration (including, but not limited to, modifications of the wheels, tires, body, engine, transmission, or other drivetrain components, computer(s), computer programming, wiring, air intake system, fuel delivery system, cooling system or other powertrain control system component) are not covered by this warranty.
5. Parts installed in a vehicle that has a GVWR greater than 8,000 lbs are not covered by this warranty
6. Parts installed in a vehicle or used in an application for which the manufacturer did not intend or if the part is installed in a vehicle other than a car, van, pick-up, or SUV are not covered by this warranty.
7. This warranty does not cover damage or failure arising directly or indirectly from improper installation (not in accordance with the original manufacturer's specifications including, but not limited to, service manual, applicable Technical Service Bulletins (TSB's), and other published documentation) or related vehicle problems, misuse, neglect, maintenance (or lack thereof), abuse, lack of lubrication, overheating, vandalism, abnormal operation, environmental conditions (including, but not limited to, lightning, earthquake, windstorm, hail, rainwater, freezing, flood, or any other act of God), accident or any damage which was apparent or not reported at the time of delivery.

General Limitations

1. This warranty is extended to the original purchaser and is not transferable. You **MUST** be able to provide an original receipt in your name for the warranty to be considered.
2. We reserve the right to have the part inspected to insure that all pertinent provisions of this warranty have been met prior to any replacement, repair or refund.
3. Cousineau Auto Parts Inc. reserves the right to review any estimate, installation documents, and maintenance documents prior to authorization for repair, replacement or refund.
4. Cousineau Auto Parts Inc. reserves the right to review work done under this warranty or warranty claim including proof such work was successfully completed.
5. Normal wear and service items are not covered in this warranty.
6. All claims require installation and maintenance receipts.
7. This warranty becomes null and void if:
 - o The part is repaired, altered, disassembled, or removed from the vehicle without prior authorization from Cousineau Auto Parts Inc..
 - o Failure is caused by a non-covered component, failure to clear computer codes, defective workmanship, or installation error.
 - o Failure is caused by towing a trailer or other vehicle unless your vehicle is equipped for this purpose as recommended by the vehicle manufacturer.
 - o The installed heat tab on the product is missing, removed, shows signs of overheating, alteration or signs of tampering.
 - o Identification marks are missing or have been removed (including, but not limited to, stamps, paint marker writing, and personalized heat tabs).
 - o The product has been installed in more than one vehicle.
 - o The product is operated outside the continental United States.
 - o There is evidence that the part was continually operated after a failure occurred.
8. Any accessories that may be attached to this part may have to be switched or removed to accommodate proper installation. This is the responsibility of the installer. Such accessories are not covered by this warranty.
9. This limited warranty gives you specific legal rights. You may have other rights which vary from state to state.
10. Cousineau Auto Parts Inc. does not authorize any person to create for it any obligation in connection with this warranty.

Specific Part Limitations

Engines: Warranty is limited to defects in the Head(s), Block, Pistons, Crankshaft, Camshaft(s), Rockers, and other internal lubricated parts. Warranty also excludes oil leaks from, but not limited to: valve cover gaskets, oil pan gaskets, timing cover gaskets, intake gaskets, front or rear seals, etc. Parts attached to the engine are Accessories and or Extra Parts and must be switched at time of installation and are not covered under the warranty.

Transmissions: Warranty is limited to the case, torque converter, and internally lubricated components. Electrical accessories such as switches, solenoids, sensors etc... are not covered under the warranty. Accessories and attached parts that may or may not be included with the transmission are not covered by the warranty and should be swapped or replaced at the time of installation. Under no circumstances will stripped, sheared, or broken teeth be covered by this warranty.

Transfer Cases: Warranty is limited to the case and internally lubricated components. Electrical accessories such as switches, solenoids, sensors, encoder motors, etc... are not covered under the warranty. Accessories and attached parts that may or may not be included with the transfer case are not covered by the warranty and should be swapped or replaced at the time of installation.

Axle Assemblies: Warranty is limited to the case and internally lubricated components. Accessories such as switches, solenoids, sensors, brake backing plates, brake shoes or discs, rotors, cables, hoses, tubing, etc ... are not covered under the warranty. Accessories and attached parts that may or may not be included with the axle assembly are not covered by the warranty and should be swapped or replaced at the time of installation

INSTALLATION GUIDELINES FOR WARRANTY VALIDATION

To validate the warranty on this part, installation must be completed within 30 days of purchase and the work indicated below must be performed and documented at the time of installation. If the part fails and you find it necessary to initiate a warranty claim, you will be required to provide documentation showing a record of the installation date, mileage, VIN, work performed, and maintenance records.

Engines:	Automatic Transmissions:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The oil screen and pickup tube MUST be cleaned or replaced. • Install new timing belt, water pump, thermostat, spark plugs, fluids, seals, oil filter, and other fluids to the proper levels using the proper fluid type in accordance with the vehicle manufacturer's guidelines (including applicable TSB's). • Flow check the radiator and replace if necessary. • Change the oil after 600 miles. • Change oil once every 3000 miles thereafter. • Service the vehicle at proper intervals in accordance with the vehicle manufacturer's guidelines. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replace all external seals, pan gasket and filter. • Replace or flush the oil cooler and lines in accordance with the vehicle manufacturer's guidelines (including applicable TSB's). • Fill transmission and differential/final drive assembly to the proper levels using the proper fluid type in accordance with the vehicle manufacturer's guidelines (including applicable TSB's). • Reset computer codes. • Adjust shifter mechanism and TV/kickdown cables.
Axle Assemblies and Transfer Cases:	Manual Transmissions:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replace seals and cover gaskets. • Fill fluids to the proper levels using the proper fluid type in accordance with the vehicle manufacturer's guidelines (including applicable TSB's). • ALL tires on the vehicle must be the same size, brand, make, model and tread depth. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replace all external seals, clutch, pressure plate, release bearing and pilot bearing. • When equipped, replace or flush the oil cooler and lines in accordance with the vehicle manufacturer's guidelines (including applicable TSB's). • Fill fluids to the proper levels using the proper fluid type in accordance with the vehicle manufacturer's guidelines (including applicable TSB's). • Adjust shifter mechanism.
